\*For learners claiming concession an approved concession card is to be sighted and copied by reception staff when processing payment, and attached to the enrolment form. Spouses and dependents of concession card holders are eligible.

Approved concession cards include:

- a) Commonwealth Health Care Card,
- b) Pensioner Concession Card, or
- c) Veterans Gold Card

No concession is available for funded learners in Diploma level qualifications.

A learner undertaking a funded course cannot pay a concession rate with a promise to provide the concession card for sighting at a later date.
